No. UBD.BR. 96/A/9/88-89.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (7) of Section 42 of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1948, the Reserve Bank of India hereby exempts every primary co-operative bank which is for the time being included in the Second Schedule to the said Act, from the proviso to sub-section (1) of Section 42 of that Act in so far as that proviso requires a scheduled primary co-operative bank to maintain an average balance in excess of 3% of the net demand and time liabilities of the bank referred to in sub-section (1). This exemption shall be in force for a period of two years from 23rd September, 1988.

No. Legal/2/88/GSR.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 19 of the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act, 1970 (5 of 1970), the Board of Directors of Allahabad Bank in consultation with the Reserve Bank of India and with the previous sanction of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulation further to amend the Allahabad Bank (Officers) Service Regulations, 1979.

2. Short title and commencement : (i) This Regulation may be called the Allahabad Bank (Officers) Service (Amendment) Regulations, 1988. (ii) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

3. (i) The Regulation 23 (v) of Allahabad Bank (Officers) Service Regulations, 1979 shall be substituted by the following :—

"23 (v) On and from 1st February, 1984, if an officers is deputed to serve outside the bank, he may opt to receive the emoluments attached to the post to which he is deputed. Alternatively, he may, in addition to his pay, draw a deputation allowance of 15% of pay and such other allowances as he would have drawn had he been posted in the Bank's service at that place.

Provided that where he is deputed to an organisation which is located at the same place where he was posted immediately prior to his deputation, he shall receive a deputation allowance equal to 7½% of his pay.

Provided further that an officer on deputation to the Training Establishment of the bank as a Faculty Member or to the Banking Service Recruitment Board, shall be eligible for deputation allowance at 7½% of his pay subject, however, that an officer on deputation to Banking Service Recruitment Board shall be eligible for such deputation allowance with effect from 29th October, 1985 and not earlier.

(ii) Regulation 23 (xi) shall be deleted.

No. A-12(11)-4/86-Ext.I(A).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 97 read with clause (xxi) of Sub-section (2) and sub-section (2A) of that Section and sub-section (2) of Section 17 of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (34 of 1948), the Employees' State Insurance Corporation hereby makes, with the approval of the Central Government, the following Regulations regulating the method of recruitment for certain categories of posts for the Management Service Unit in the Employees' State Insurance Corporation, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement :—

(1) These regulations may be called the Employees' State Insurance Corporation Management Service Unit Recruitment Regulations, 1988. 4

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Number, classification and its scale of pay :—

The number of the post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the respective schedule.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc :—

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the respective schedules.

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4. Qualification :—

No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts :

Provided that the Director General of the Corporation may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this regulation.

5. Power to relax :

Where the Director General of the Corporation is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, after taking prior approval of the Central Government and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these regulations with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

Nothing in these regulations shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
